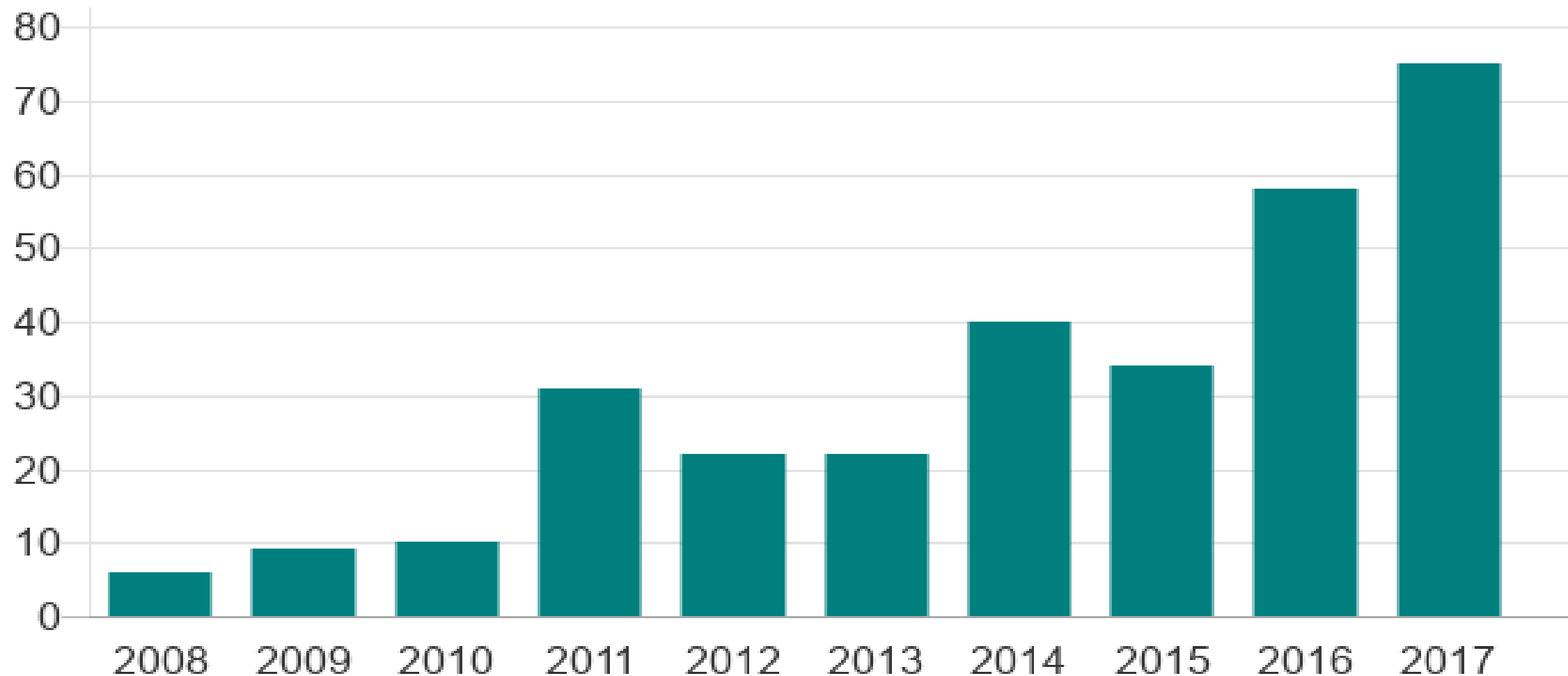

Deaths from fentanyl increased by 29% last year

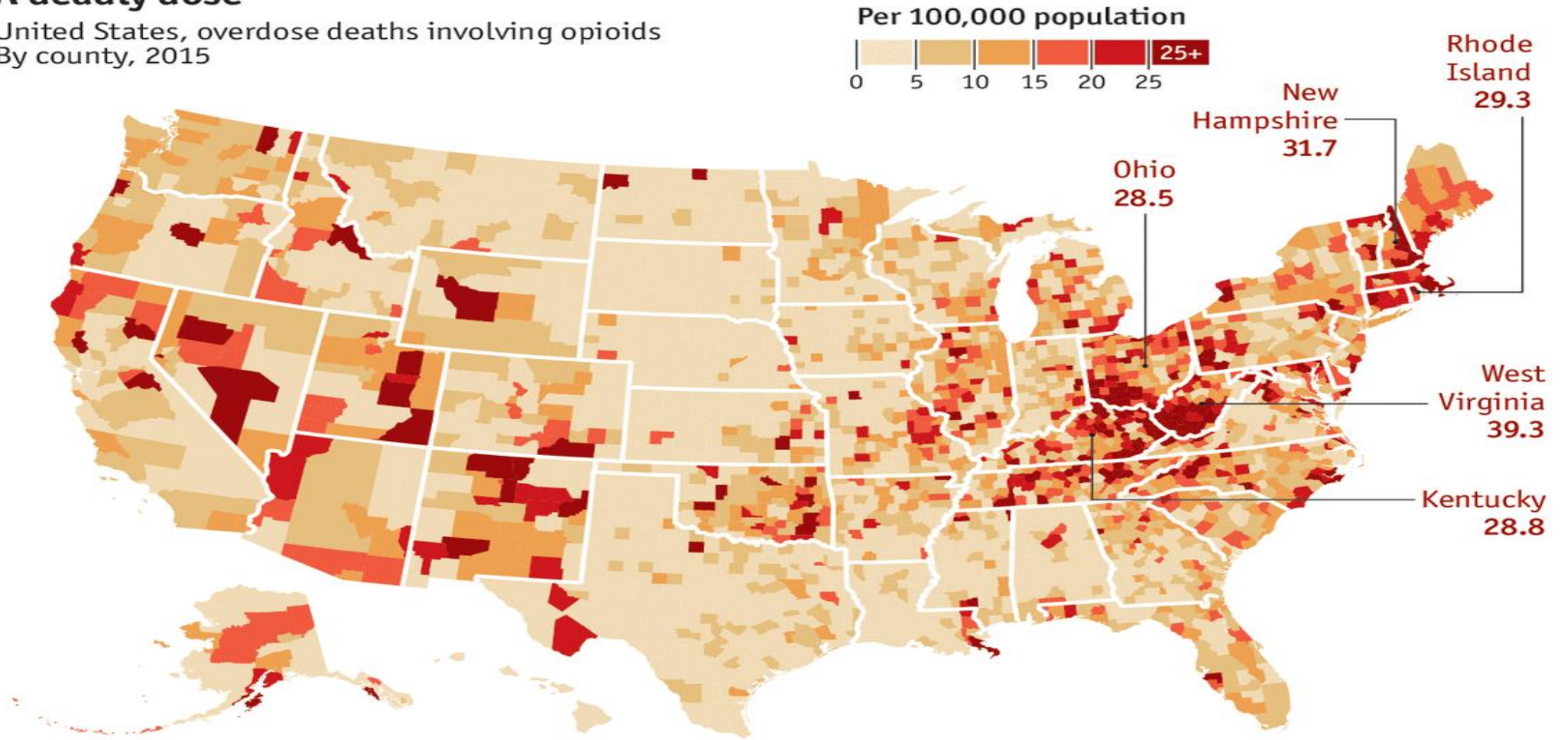

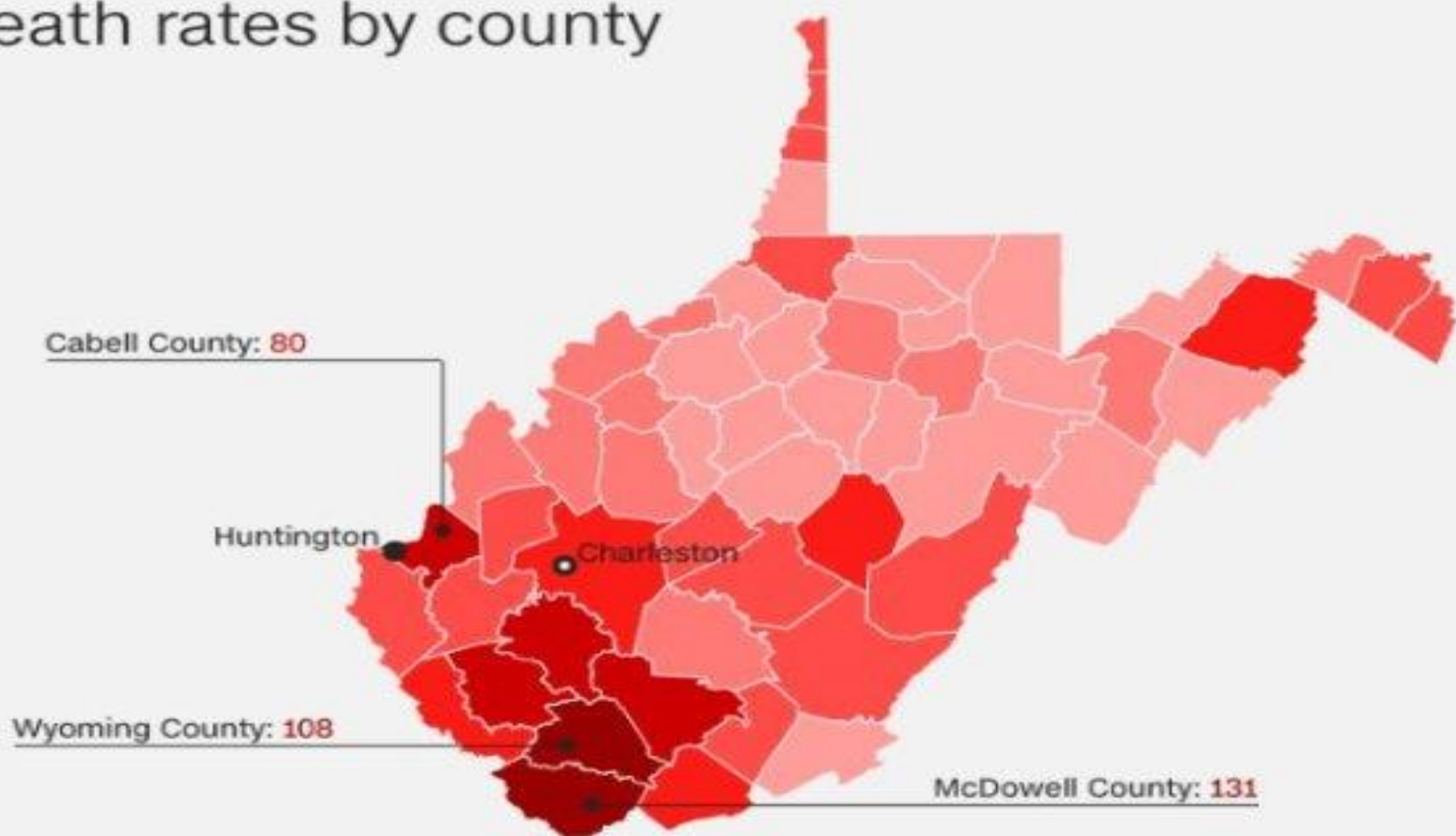
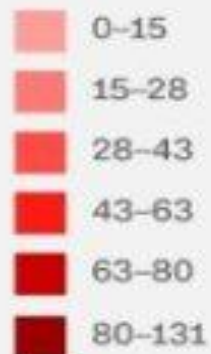

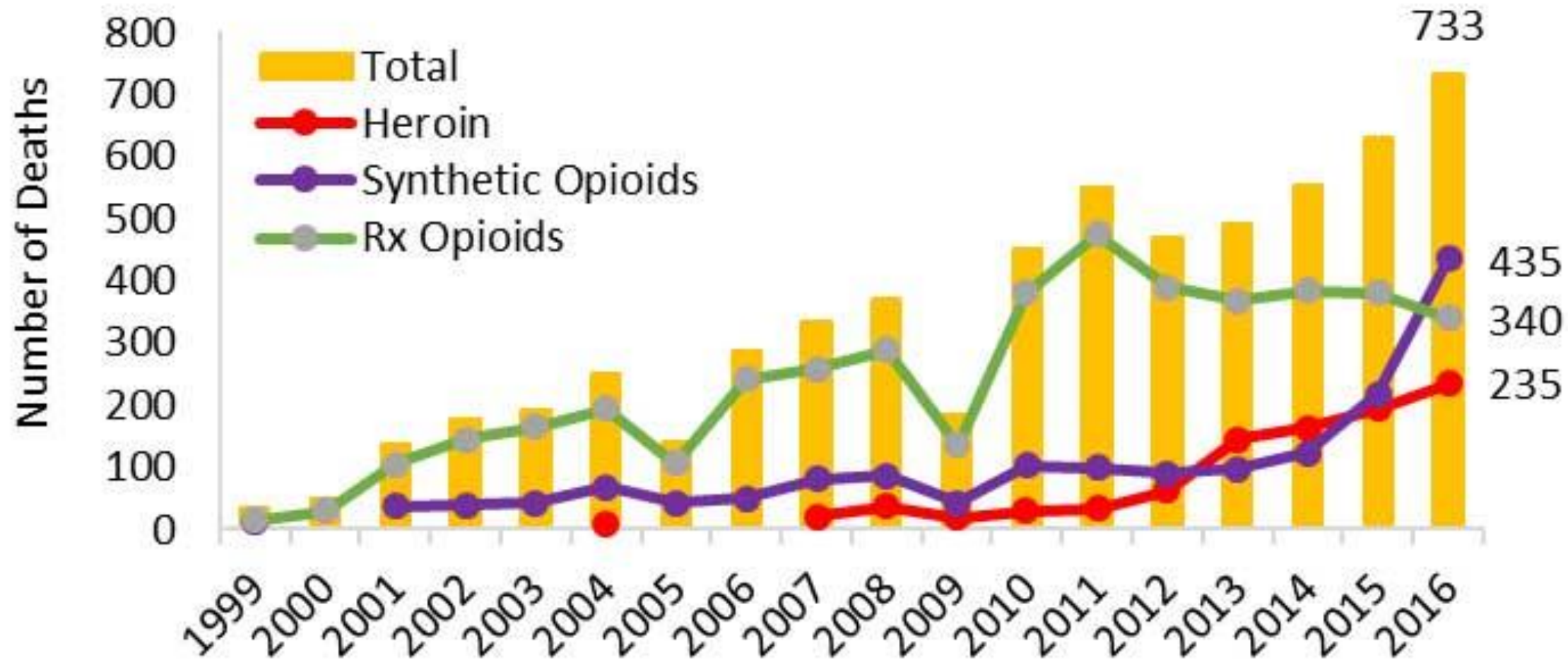
Overdose death rates by county

per 100,000 people

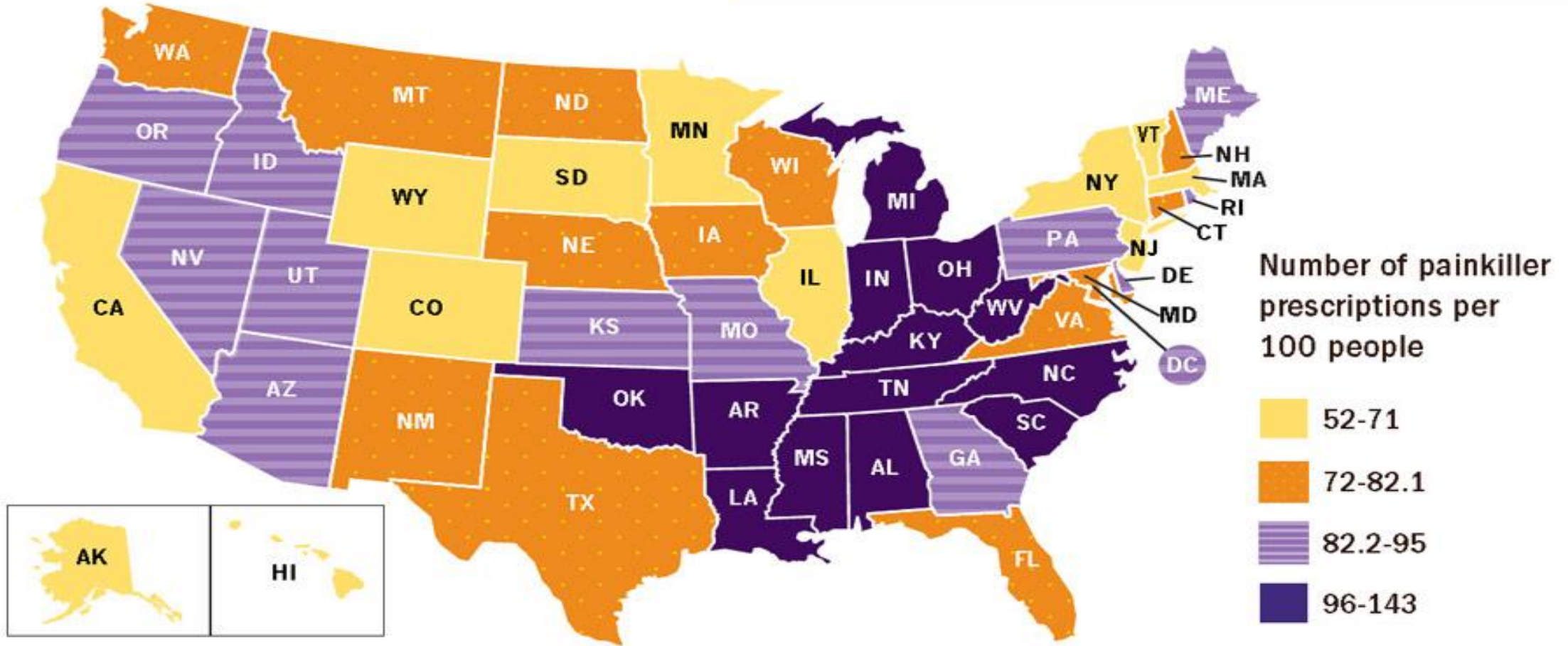


Number of Opioid Related Overdose Deaths in West Virginia



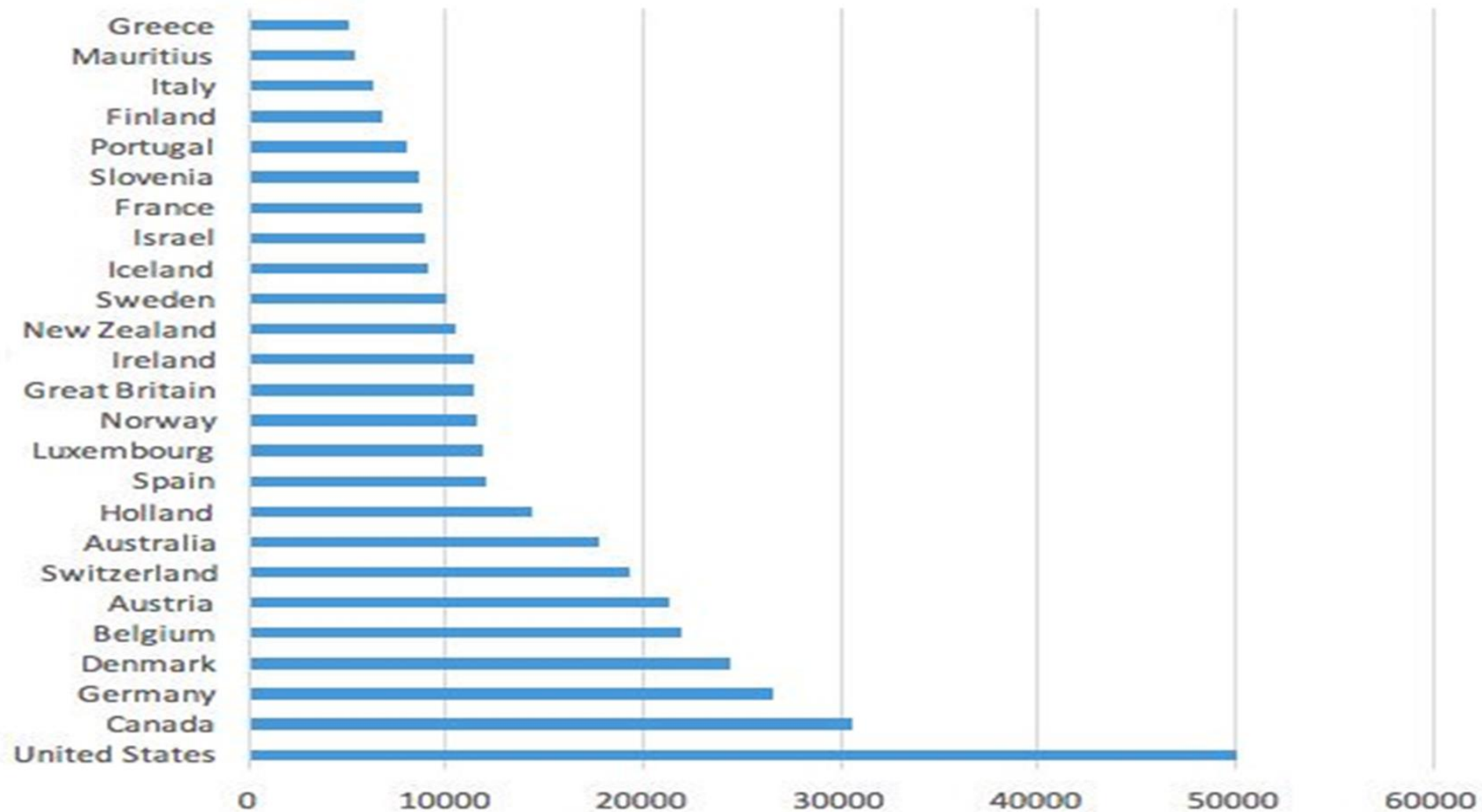

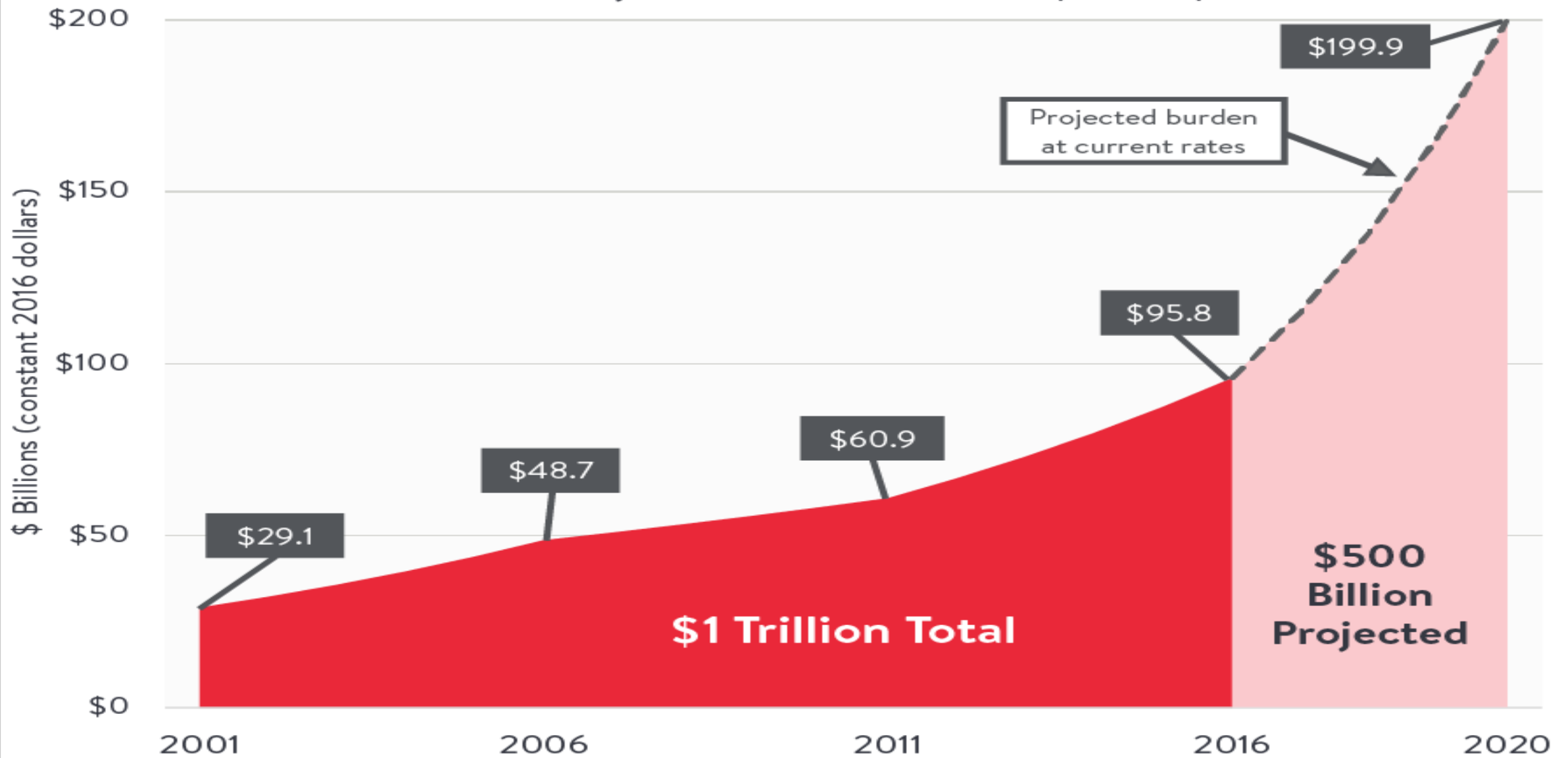

Standard Daily Doses of Opioids per Million Inhabitants

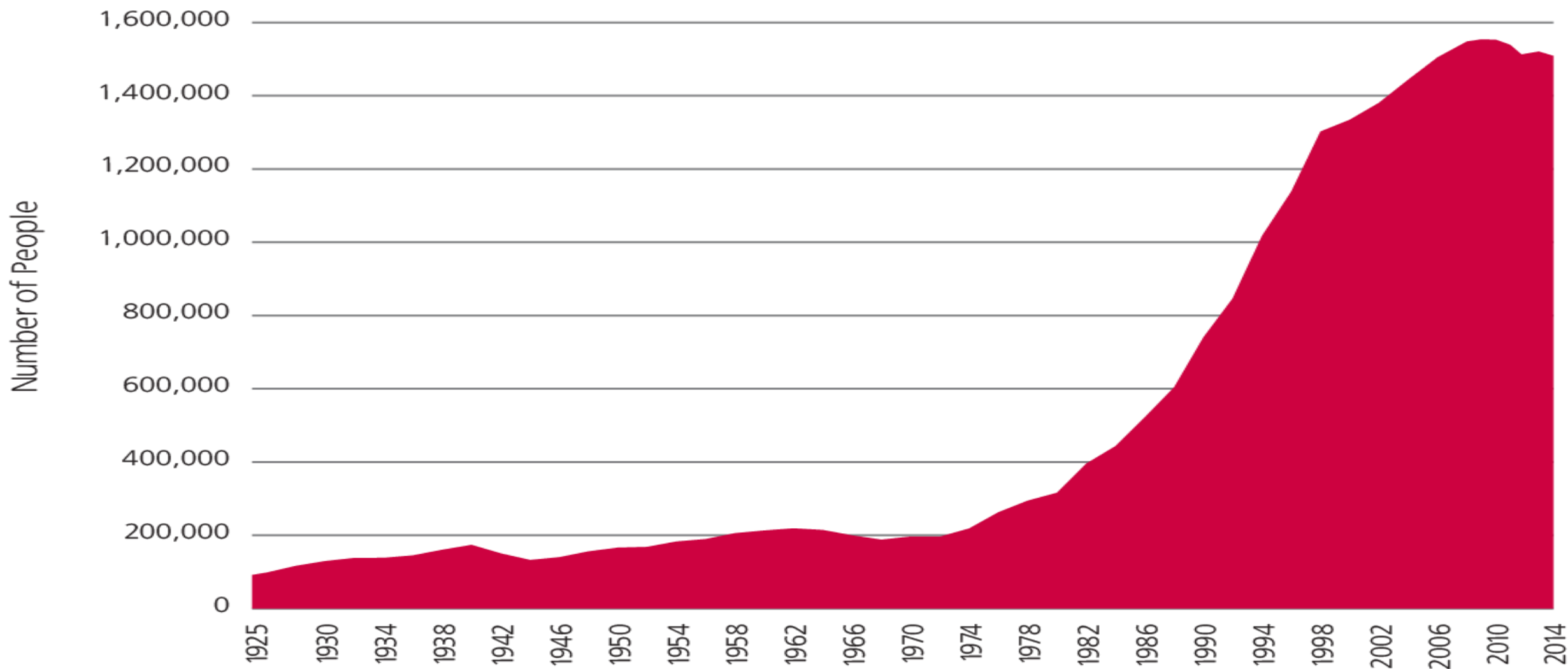


Total and Projected Costs of the Opioid Epidemic



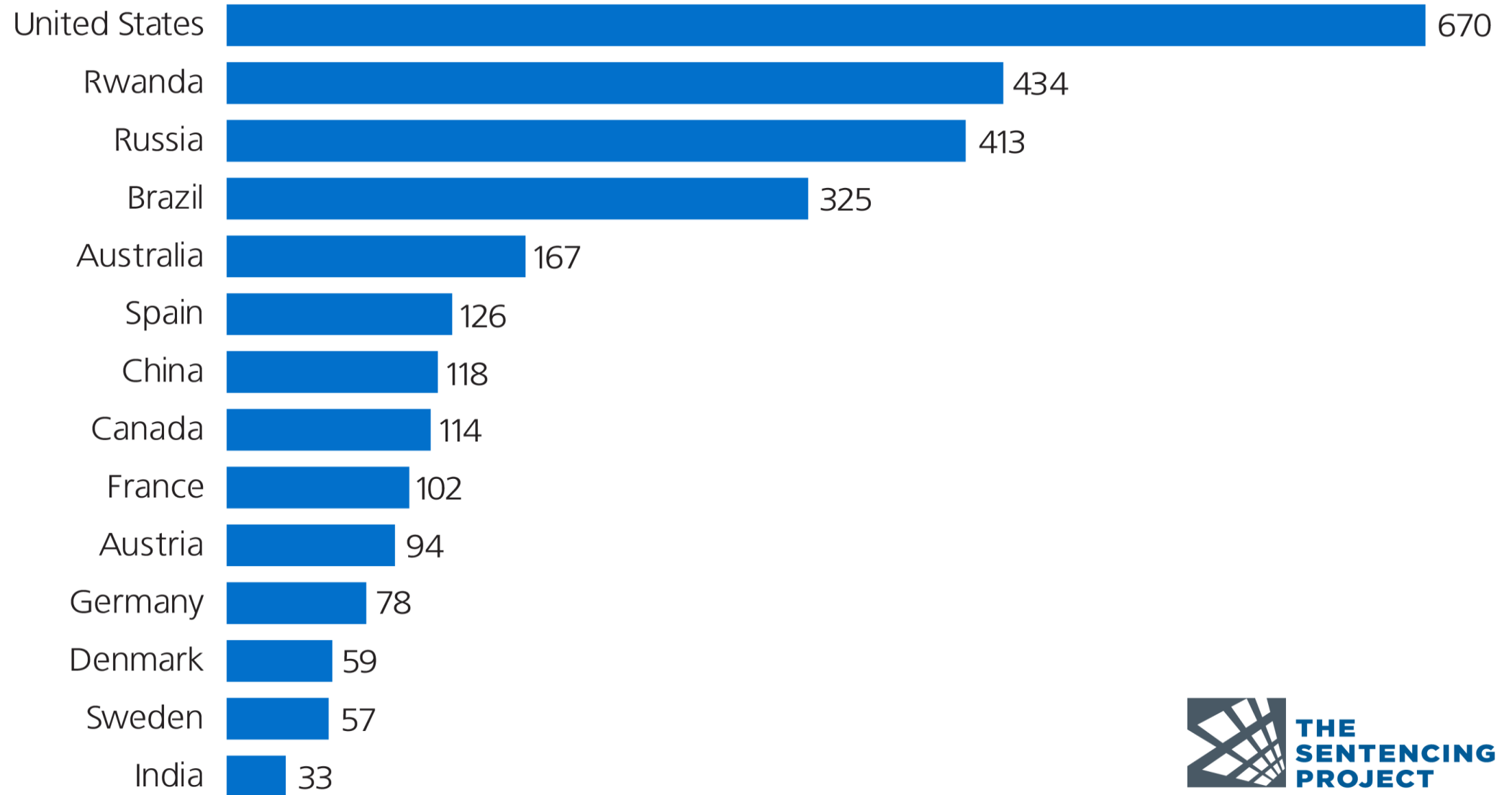

U.S. State and Federal Prison Population, 1925-2014

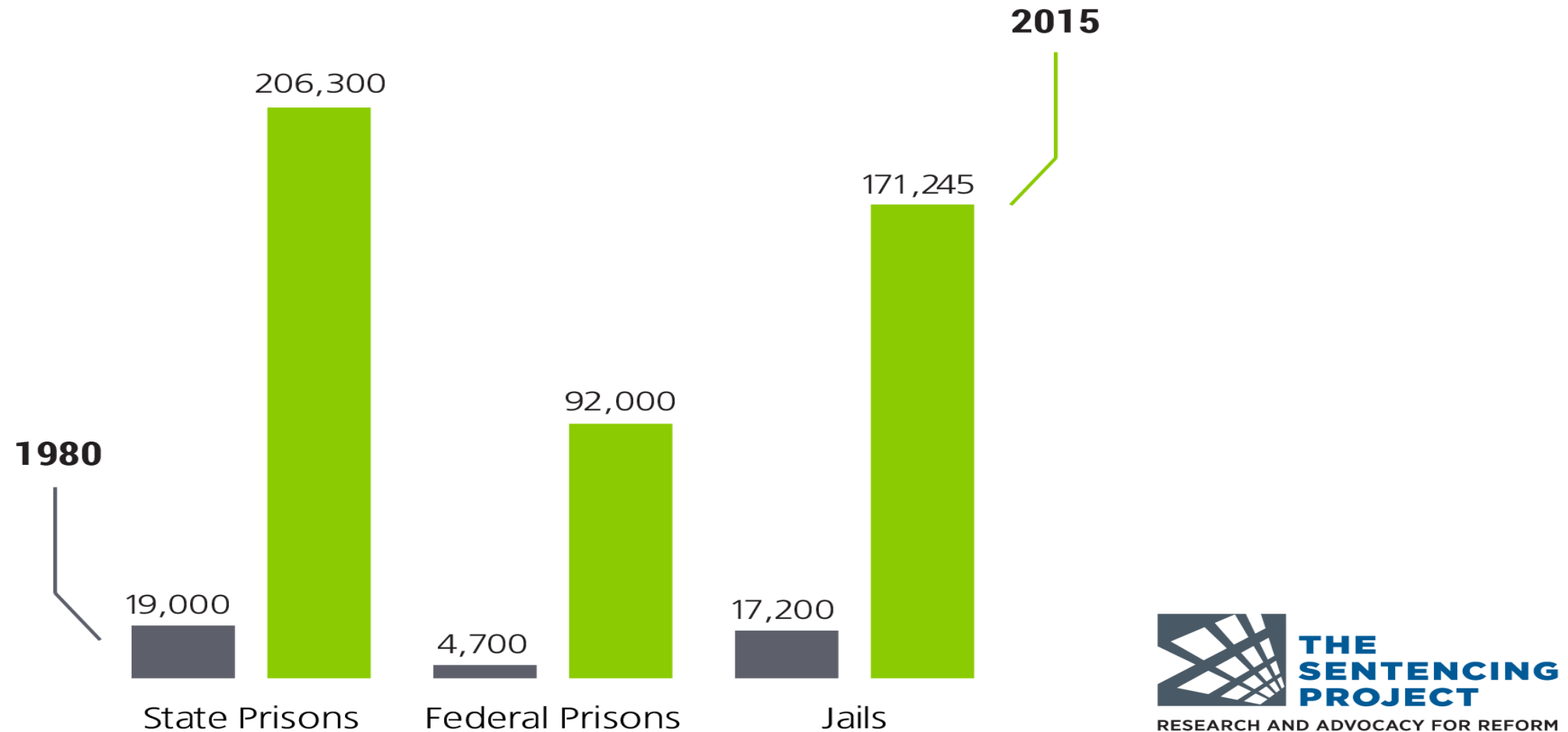

International Rates of Incarceration per 100,000

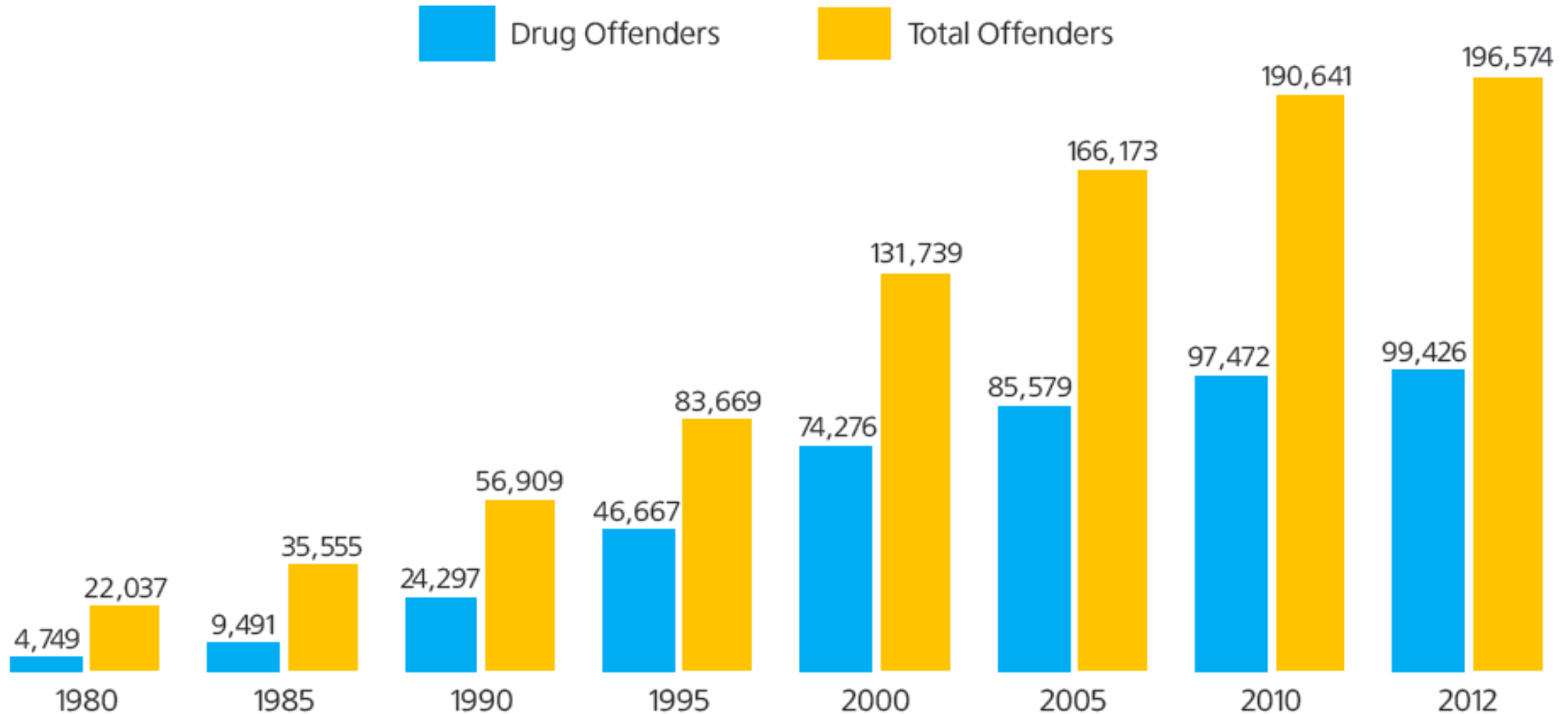


Number of People in Prisons and Jails for Drug Offenses, 1980 and 2015

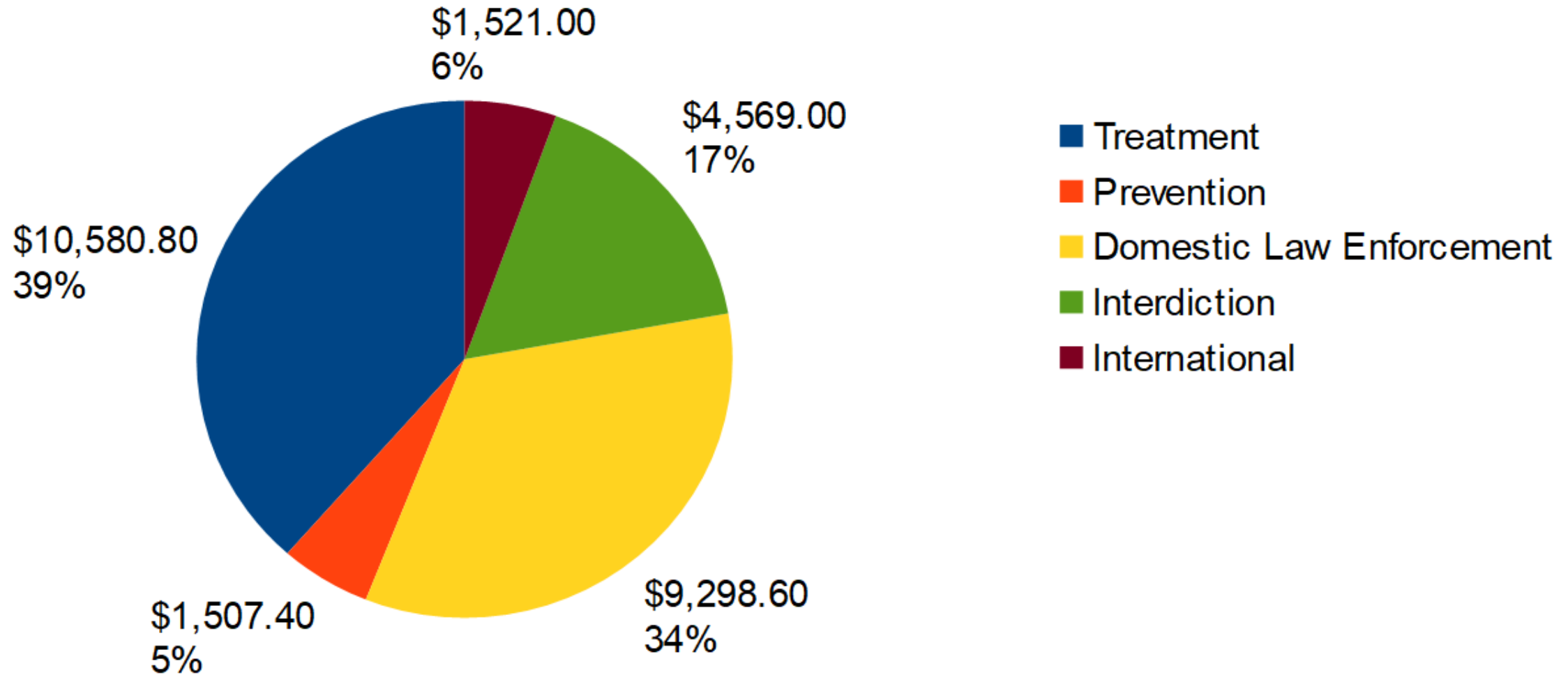
Number of People in Federal Prisons for Drug Offenses, 1980-2012
